The community

Barrow-upon-Soar is a large village in Leicestershire and is pleasantly situated on the east side of the River Soar, and on both sides of the Midland Railway.

The village is 3 miles S.E. of Loughborough, and 9 miles north of Leicester and is known for a [plesiosaur](#) that was [excavated](#) here in 1851. The specimen of [Atychodracon megacephalus](#), found in a lime pit outside the village, was nicknamed the "Barrow Kipper".

At the centre of the village is a roundabout with a sign depicting its skeleton. The skeleton is now on display at the [Leicester Museum & Art Gallery](#), with a full-size replica at [Charnwood Museum](#) in Loughborough.

Barrow upon Soar is a popular bustling village with a full range of shops and local amenities close to open countryside, yet within commuting distance of Loughborough and Leicester via the train station.

There are fantastic schools within the catchment area together with a range of interesting independent shops, tearooms, six public houses and accommodation.
