SEE

POUR AROUND 100ML OF BEER IN YOUR GLASS AND HOLD IT UP TO THE LIGHT, BEER IS CATEGORISED INTO GOLDEN, AMBER AND DARK, EACH WITH A SPECTRUM OF SHADES WITHIN IT.

SMELL

COVER WITH YOUR HAND AND SWIRL THE BEER IN THE GLASS. CLOSE YOUR EYES TO IMPROVE YOUR SENSE OF SMELL AND POP YOUR NOSE INTO YOUR GLASS AND TAKE A DEEP SNIFF. WHAT NOTES CAN YOU PICK UP? TOFFEE? LEMON, MALT, SHERRY.

TASTE

TAKE SOME SMALL SIPS, FOLLOWED BY A LONG SLOW ONE AND SWIRL THE BEER AROUND YOUR MOUTH. WHERE ON YOUR TONGUE CAN YOU TASTE IT? IS IT BITTER OR SWEET? WHAT FLAVOURS CAN YOU TASTE? SPICY HOP, FRUIT?
