## The community

The Birch Tree sits on the top of Bardon Hill, on the main road into Coalville.

Bardon Hill is a former volcano and is the highest point in Leicestershire after Beacon Hill.

Close to the pub, you will find Bradgate Park and Sense Valley Park and Coalville town centre is only a twenty-minute walk or five-minute drive away.

The pub sits on the A50 and is only 5 minutes away from Junction 22 of the M1 so gets a lot of passing trade and commuters stopping for a well earned food and drink break.
